Dear Mount St. Mary Community,

Mount St. Mary Catholic High School has a rich tradition of educational excellence that began in 1903 and has endured for over a century. For nearly 120 years, our school has attracted young men and women who desire to be formed in the exceptional values of the Sisters of Mercy as well as our Archdiocese of Oklahoma City. As we reflect on the past year and the lessons that Covid has taught us, we have a clearer understanding of our strengths as a school and are working to capitalize on those strengths. As a result, I am happy to announce a new academic program for the 2021-2022 school year called the ***Diploma of Distinction***.

The Diploma of Distinction Program is an **optional** curricular pathway that students can select to be a part of. In the fall of 2021, Mount St. Mary will offer ten Diploma of Distinction paths that allow students to focus their elective choices so they can learn the things they love. The Diploma of Distinction Program allows students to focus on their interests and aspirations for college and their future careers. Our DoD options for the upcoming school year are: Business & Technology; Engineering; STEM; Servant Leadership; Letters; Athletics; Renaissance Thinker; Music; Performing Arts; and Visual Art.

Mount St. Mary graduates are required to earn 28 credits, four more than the state requires. Students who complete the Diploma of Distinction Program are required to earn 31 credits, and 5.5 of those are focused in specific electives. DoD students are also required to complete a program-specific Capstone that culminates in a presentation of the student's research to the Mount St. Mary community. Students interested in the Diploma of Distinction are required to opt-in by the end of their sophomore year. For the 21-22 school year, rising seniors are able to opt-into a program if they have they will be able to complete a Diploma of Distinction by graduation. There is no penalty for students changing their DoD selection or for dropping the program.

We believe that students who embark on a Diploma of Distinction pathway are committing themselves to a challenging and even more rigorous academic experience. As recognition for their accomplishment, students who graduate with a Diploma of Distinction will receive recognition for their outstanding achievement at graduation.

We are very excited to be able to offer this program to our students. We know their efforts at Mount St. Mary will lead to a lifetime of success which will guide them to carry the Mercy Spirit within them for the rest of their lives.
