

Growing leaders since 1903.

For over 115 years, students have made history, memories, and discoveries at Mount St. Mary. Five Sisters of Mercy traveled to Indian Territory in 1884 to establish a school for young ladies. The school, located at Sacred Heart Mission near Konawa, succumbed to a severe fire.

In 1900 the land now occupied by the school was donated to the Sisters. The Sisters built, what was at that time, the tallest building in the city on a hill one mile south of downtown Oklahoma City. The cornerstone was laid on December 12, 1903 (4 years before statehood).

Young ladies arrived from all areas of the United States to be educated at Mount St. Mary's Academy. In 1950, Bishop Eugene McGuinness asked the Sisters to consider expanding their education to include young men. Since that time, Mount St. Mary Catholic High School has been coeducational. The Mount has a long history of educating the youth of Oklahoma. For over 100 years, we have been committed to continuing the tradition of excellence in Catholic Christian education begun by the Sisters of Mercy and supported by the Catholic Archdiocese of Oklahoma City who formed a cosponsorship maintained since 2002.





Connect with Your Faith.

As students journey through their four years at Mount St. Mary, the Campus Ministry Department seeks to play an important part in helping to foster each student's personal and spiritual growth. Campus ministry provides numerous faith-filled opportunities to build and strengthen each student's relationship with God and others. School Masses, spiritual retreats, prayer groups, Bible study, and more give students the chance to witness and become

disciples of Christ. One of the most important ways that students demonstrate discipleship is through service. Recognizing the needs of others gives our students a sense of purpose and the power to make a difference. Every student participates in multiple projects each year during class project days as well as through club and athletic team sponsored community service.

Every year The Mount hosts a school-wide retreat to cultivate connection and spiritual growth.


ACADEM

Small Classes. Big Experiences.

Mount St. Mary Catholic High School seeks to effectively prepare students for college and their future careers. Whether you have specialized learning needs and require additional support or succeed in more challenging programs, The Mount's college-prep academic tracks fit what is right for each student. In addition to the traditional college-prep courses, MSM offers 21 AP courses; honors courses; and STEM classes. MSM offers the PLUSS Program and Cornerstone

Inclusion Program, allowing students with diagnosed learning needs the opportunity to reach their full potential in an inclusive environment.

With students' success always in mind, The Mount keeps classes small with a 12:1 student to faculty ratio and class sizes under 25 students to foster a close student-teacher relationship that is important to successful learning. Our school day features an A/B college- block schedule with each student enrolled in eight courses. Students attend four 80-minute classes each day, alternating their four "A day" classes with four different "B day" classes. Academic Period is a 45-minute study time held Tuesday-Friday consisting of a small group of students from mixed grade levels and a teacher to promote teacher-to-student and student-to-student mentoring opportunities.



The athletic programs at MSM seek to provide an experience of Christian competition that allows students to develop athletic skills and personal qualities. 96% of MSM students choose to participate in extracurricular clubs or athletics each year.

MSM is a member in good standing with the Oklahoma Secondary Schools Activities Association (OSSAA), and our athletic teams are eligible to compete in State Tournament play. Athletic activities are open to students in grades 9-12 and provide opportunities for students to become involved not only as players but as managers, trainers, or statisticians.
